This past year we have seen a testament of the Lord's faithfulness firsthand! As the work of the ministry continues to adapt and grow, it is clear that God is caring for and protecting the abortion-vulnerable women and babies we serve. Through his provision and your support, we are able to champion life in the city of Houston in new and exciting ways!

Here are some of our 2019 major milestones:

- Opened our second aftercare home providing housing and support for both mom and baby for up to 14 months.
- Launched our social enterprise program, Seed Two Harvest. Seed Two Harvest is a line of safe, everyday products that provides jobs and funds to women in unplanned pregnancies as well as life to the unborn.
- More than doubled the number of women & children served through LifeLine, our non-residential program for past residents. LifeLine walks alongside LifeHouse alumnae and their babies through monthly events, continued discipleship, and support groups.
- Established our first fundraiser led by our young professional's group, Champions of Life, to usher in the next generation for life in the city of Houston.
- Hired a full-time residential program manager to provide on-going support to our full-time missionaries and residents of all three homes.

In John 14:18, God promises us He will not leave us as orphans but will come to us. Our prayer is that God will continue to use the ministry as a vessel to pursue the fatherless and call them into a permanent family with Him. At LifeHouse, we seek to sow seeds of generational change by walking alongside mothers long after they give birth. Our family model of ministry not only shows vulnerable women an example of the family God calls us to, but also invites them into the LifeHouse family forever!


Thank you for uniting with us to change the trajectory of lives for generations to come!
